**Old Business:**

Consider having stewardship moments during the church service. Stewardship is a year around process, reaching out and caring. It is more than just money, it is time and talents. The church needs to communicate what the church is doing in the way of stewardship. The church has low expectations of what membership involves. Stewardship is a form of worship. Programs of caring about people, not money – Topics could be helping prevent strokes and heart attacks. Pastor Bill Kerr to draft letter, Doug Ricci to put together list of churches. Reviewed letter, important to establish active communications with churches, we need to establish focus on coming year. Key People for regions from this committee are: We changed the people responsible for establishing active communications with the churches to the links to the coordinating teams (Rev Dave Borden - Lake Shore, Pastor Bill Kerr – Algaze.
